## **SESSION 2023-24** **Exam Scheme for Class VI to VIII**

We at Delhi Public Elementary School has our Assessment Scheme Strictly aligned with NEP 2020 that is emphasized on Holistic development, Child Centric learning and Five Fold development (Pachkosha Vikas mentioned at Pg 20 of Sept 2022 Draft)

### **(A) Scholastic Area**

**Following are the four major Exams to be conducted in a Session**

- (a) Periodic Assessment 1 (PA-1)** – Periodic Test-1 (Pen and Paper Test – 40 Marks having Weightage – 10 Marks) + 5 Marks Copy Correction + 5 Marks Subject Enrichment Activity = 20 Marks
- (b) Mid Term Examination** - 80 Marks Pen and Paper
- (c) Term – 1 Calculation** = 80 Marks Half Yearly Exam + 20 Marks Periodic Assessment-1 = 100 Marks.
- (d) Periodic Assessment 2 (PA-2)** - (Pen and Paper Test – 40 Marks having Weightage – 10 Marks) + 5 Marks Copy Correction + 5 Marks Subject Enrichment Activity = 20 Marks
- (e) Annual Examination** - 80 Marks Pen and Paper
- (f) Term-2 Calculation** = 80 Marks Yearly Exam + 20 Marks Periodic Assessment-2 = 100 Marks.
- (g) Total Marks = Term-1(100 Marks) + Term-2(100 Marks) = 200 Marks**

### **NOTE:**

- (1) Dates are already mentioned in the Academic Calendar and Time Table
- (2) Events and Celebration for Co-curricular activity is also mentioned which forms a very important part of Holistic development.
- (3) Students must Pass both the Exam separately by securing 33% Marks to get promoted to the next class.
- (4) No Re-Exam request will be entertained (only Medical cases may be reviewed by the end of the session)
